## Free Buyer's Guide - Pepper Spray, Which Product Is Best For You?

Oleoresin capsicum defense sprays are commonly referred to as pepper spray or OC spray. Oleoresin is a mixture of a resin and an essential oil occurring naturally in various plants. Oleo refers to the oil. Capsicum denotes any of any of several varieties of chilies with pungent fleshy pods such as a cayenne or habaneros.

**Sensation of Heat:** Heat is measured in Scoville Heat Units (SHU). The higher the SHU rating, the greater potential for the product to be effective.

**Percentage of OC:** Most products range between 2% and 10%. Percentage of OC is not as important as the SHU rating. It does not matter how many jalapenos you eat they will never be as hot as a single ghost pepper.

## Type of Delivery:

- 1. Foam
- 2. Gel
- 3. Stream
- 4. Fog

The first three listed above primarily affect the eyes, which means you must get the product in the eyes to achieve maximum effect. This can be difficult with a single assailant, much less multiple assailants.

The fog envelops them in an aerosol cone, like cooking spray or hair spray, and has maximum effect on both the eyes and respiratory system.

**Size:** 1.5 to 2-ounce canisters are large enough to have enough spray to give you a reasonable chance of effectively dealing with the threat, while still being small enough to comfortably conceal for most people. Smaller canisters might not have enough spray, larger canisters can be too large to conceal comfortably.

**Safeties:** Under stress the brain wants fast, easy and natural. A stiff, recessed button is fast, easy and natural to use. Canisters without a button safety should be carried in an empty pocket, so nothing presses the button by accident. A reasonable safety is a flip top safety, which will help prevent the button being pressed by accident but still allows you to press the button without deactivating a safety (see video).

**Ultraviolet Dye:** Ultraviolet dye cannot be seen or washed off by the criminal, but the police can use a special light to see the dye, which connect the criminal to the crime.
